Leicestershire Police, a medium sized UK police force, deployed the Kinesense LE video investigation solution in 2021. With access across the force, the solution has become vital to investigations where large amounts of CCTV and video footage are seized and need to be reviewed, assisting officers who mainly investigate serious and complex crime. Prior to roll out, officers and staff would have to sit and physically watch and review hours and hours, even days, of CCTV, looking for key evidence and manually logging everything that is and is not relevant to the investigation, whilst ensuring they meet their duties as per the Criminal Procedure and Investigations Act (CPIA 1996).

Live Trial

Following a successful trial by both East Midlands Special Operations Unit's Major Crime and Serious Organised Crime Teams in 2020, during which they tested and compared several different vendor's solutions on live and current operations, Leicestershire's Digital Hub also purchased eight additional Kinesense LE machine licences, deploying workstations across the force for officers and staff to use when required.

Result

Kinesense has now significantly reduced the amount of time they have to spend manually reviewing the footage. It allows for the officer or staff member to easily ingest any format of CCTV to the workstation, highlight an area of the footage of particular note or interest (i.e., a doorway, vehicle, window, area of a street, etc) or keep the entirety of the screen and play this through the software. It quickly highlights the parts of the footage where it has identified movement, so the reviewing officer/staff member can skip straight to it to review and then export key video clips, tag key events and automatically create detailed intelligence reports.
